

A Message From the Chief of Police:

March ended with reductions in crime in all categories. Index offenses are down 9% from February and 14% from March of last year. Violent crimes remained the same with two reported incidents in March and February. Violent crimes are down by 67% compared to March of 2018 and down 22% as compared to fiscal year to date 2018.

Property crimes are down 9% compared to February 2019 and the majority of these offenses were generated from burglaries of unlocked vehicles. Please remember, car burglars are opportunistic. If the car is locked and your valuables are removed or hidden from view, they will pass by your car looking for one that is unlocked.
