

**A Message From the Chief of Police:**

May UCR numbers show a 42% drop in violent crimes over last month and this same period last year. Thefts are up 31% over last month with increases in retail shoplifting. This contributed to a 20% increase in property crimes for the month of May. Compared to this same time last year all crimes are down by double digits compared to May of 2017 and FYTD 2017.

Our motor vehicle theft increased last month from 1 in April to 2 in May. Remember to lock your vehicles when you leave them and do not leave valuables in them.
