

A Message From the Chief of Police:

May ended with reductions in Index Offenses by 24% with a 25% reduction in violent crimes. Violent crimes showed a reduction of 50% compared to May of 2018 and a reduction of 30% year to date compared to 2018. With the communities help in locking their vehicle doors and taking valuables out of the car, we saw an 80% reduction in motor vehicle thefts for May compared to last month.
