

A Message From the Chief of Police:

May ended with increases in all crime categories when compared to April. FYTD numbers are down by 20% for total index offenses and property crimes when compared to FYTD 2019. When compared to May of 2019, we saw reductions in Index offenses by 9% and reductions in property crimes by 22%.

May ended with an increase in violent crimes when compared to April with eight offenses reported in this month and five for April. We have seen an increase in assaults, which we attribute to the stresses of COVID-19 and sheltering in place.
