

**A Message From the Chief of Police:**

November ended with a reduction in all categories as compared to last year. Index offenses down 16%, violent crimes down 7% and property crimes down 17%. We did see an increase of 31% in index offenses and 48% in property crimes as compared to October. These increases are not unexpected for this time of year with increases in retail thefts during the holiday months. Violent crimes were down 50% over Octobers numbers. The men and women of the Terrell Police Department wish for a very happy and safe Christmas to all of you.
