

A Message From the Chief of Police:

November ended with reductions in all categories with the exception of motor vehicle thefts which were up by 3 compared to Octobers numbers. When compared to November of 2018, we are down 14% in total index offenses, down 75% in violent crimes and down 9% for property crimes. Fiscal year to date numbers are down 42% for violent crimes when compared to FYTD 2018 with slight rise in property crimes up 7%. Remember; during this Christmas season do not leave valuables in your vehicle. If you cannot take them with you hide them and make sure your vehicle is locked. Unfortunately, this is prime vehicle burglary season. Do not make it easy for them.

Stay vigilant and report any suspicious activity you see.
