

A Message From the Chief of Police:

October begins our new fiscal year with reductions in total index offenses by 21% over September. Property crimes are down 30% from Septembers numbers. We did see an increase in violent crimes from 4 reported in September to 8 reported in October. Our fiscal year to date numbers compared to last fiscal year show 30% decrease in index offenses and a 35% decrease in property crimes for the period.

Statistically our 9-year monthly average is 60 index offense, 8 violent crimes and 53 property crimes per month. October ended with a reduction of 25% in index offenses and reduction of 30% in property crimes over the monthly average.
