

**A Message From the Chief of Police:**

September ended our fiscal year down in all categories. Total index offenses are down 23% compared to FY 2017. Property crimes dropped from 853 offenses in FY 2017 to 635 offenses for this fiscal year, a drop of 25%. Violent crimes are down by 5% as compared to FY 2017. September showed a 12% reduction in offense totals compared to last month. Violent crimes are down 69% from last month from 13 offenses in August to 4 offenses this month.

Overall not a bad end to our 2018 fiscal year. We thank all of our community partners for your help in making Terrell a safer community.
