

A Message From the Chief of Police:

January's crime numbers show a steady decrease in Index Offense Totals down 22% from December and 35% lower than Fiscal Year to Date 2017. Violent crimes fell by 71% from December and are down by 76% compared to January of 2017. Property crimes showed the smallest change down 10% from last month. One area of concern is our motor vehicle theft. We had 1 in December and 6 in January. Several of these incidents had keys left in the vehicles. It is important to remember to lock your vehicle doors and take your keys with you.
