

A Message From the Chief of Police:

July ended with a reduction in overall index offenses by 14%. Violent crimes are down 11% and property crimes are down 15% from June. Compare fiscal year to date 2018 with the same period fiscal year 2017, we see a reduction in overall index offenses by 25% with a 6% reduction in violent crimes and a 27% reduction in property crimes.

These reductions in criminal offenses are the result of strong partnerships within our community that foster trust and transparency between the community and the Terrell Police Department.
