

A Message From the Chief of Police:

July ended with a sharp increase in retail theft up from 23 reported in June to 50 reported this month. Violent crimes dropped by 2 offenses from 6 reported in June to 4. Overall reported Index offenses were up substantially because of the increase in retail thefts.

When we compare July 2020 to July 2019 we reductions in all categories. Compared to Fiscal Year to Date 2019 we are down 11% for violent crimes and down 23% for property crimes.

July saw an increase in vehicle burglaries in residential areas. These were primarily unlocked vehicles with valuables stored inside. Thieves are opportunistic; if your vehicle is left unlocked, you are an easy target. Lock your car and take valuable items with you.
