

A Message From the Chief of Police:

We ended June down in all categories except Violent Crimes, which were up 6 more offenses over May. The increase was attributed to a rise in aggravated assaults. We are down 8% over last year's YTD totals for violent crimes. Historically we average 7 violent crimes per month with an increase usually seen in the heat of the summer.

Total Offenses fell 25% and Property crimes are down 27% over this same period last year.
We ask that you remain vigilant and report and suspicious activity.
