

RESOLUTION NO. 884

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, TO LEASE FLEET VEHICLES THROUGH ENTERPRISE FLEET MANAGEMENT, INC. THROUGH THE INTERLOCAL PURCHASING SYSTEM (TIPS) OFFERED BY REGION VIII EDUCATION SERVICE CENTER AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THE GOVERNMENT CREDIT APPLICATION, ENTERPRISE MASTER EQUITY LEASE AGREEMENT, MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT AND FLEET RENTAL AGREEMENT AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT AND ALL NECESSARY REQUESTS AND DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, on February 20, 2018, the City Council of the City of Terrell, Texas, passed and approved Resolution No. 880 authorizing the City of Terrell to apply for membership in the TIPS Purchasing Cooperative offered by Region VIII Education Service Center; and

WHEREAS, on March 2, 2018, the membership of the City of Terrell was approved and the City entered into an Interlocal Agreement with Region VIII Education Service Center; and

WHEREAS, the City has selected Enterprise Fleet Management, Inc., a vendor through the TIPS program and has completed the procedure to lease its fleet vehicles from Enterprise Fleet Management, Inc., and

WHEREAS, the City deems it to be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Terrell, Texas, to utilize this vendor through the TIPS program for the lease of the fleet vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:


Section 1: That the City Council recognizes that the vendors approved by The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS) offered by Region VIII Education Service Center offer cost savings to its members.

Section 2: That leasing the fleet vehicles through Enterprise Fleet Management, Inc. will be highly beneficial to the taxpayers of the City of Terrell, Texas, through the anticipated savings to be realized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Government Credit Application, the Master Equity Lease Agreement, the Maintenance Management And Fleet Rental Agreement, the Maintenance Agreement and all additional documents in connection therewith for and on behalf of The City of Terrell, Texas, to lease the fleet vehicles from Enterprise Fleet Management, Inc.


Section 4: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and it is accordingly so resolved.
