

RESOLUTION NO. 897

A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE BALLOTS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 6, 2018, IN THE CITY OF TERRELL TEXAS, VOTING FOR OR AGAINST PROPOSITION A; REDUCING THE TYPE A SALES AND USE TAX TO A RATE OF THREE EIGHTHS OF ONE PERCENT AND FOR THE CREATION OF A TYPE B SALES AND USE TAX AT THE RATE OF ONE EIGHTH OF ONE PERCENT TO BE USED FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN PUBLIC PARKS AND DOWNTOWN

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Terrell, Texas, adopted Resolution No. 888 calling a Special Election to be held in said City on November 6, 2018, to vote For or Against Proposition A; reducing the Type A Sales and Use Tax to a rate of three eighths of one percent and creating a Type B Sales and Use Tax at the rate of one eighth of one percent for capital improvements in public parks and downtown; and

WHEREAS, said Special Election was duly held at the time and at the place specified in the Resolution after due notice as required by law had been given; and

WHEREAS, a total of 877 ballots were cast For and Against Proposition A; and

WHEREAS, only the qualified voters of the City of Terrell, Texas, were allowed to vote in said Special Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, THAT:

The Special Election held on November 6, 2018, was duly called and notice was given in accordance with the law and in accordance with the Resolution calling for said Special Election.

The Special Election was held in accordance with applicable state statutes and ordinances of the City of Terrell, Texas, and the following votes were cast in the respective places designated.
