

RESOLUTION NO. 915

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS RATIFYING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE CITY MANAGER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF TERRELL FIRE DEPARTMENT A STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (“SAFER”) GRANT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY/FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENT NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THIS GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency has awarded a grant to the City of Terrell Fire Department under the FY 2018 Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (“SAFER”) grant program in the amount of One Million Sixty-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$1,069,715.00); and

WHEREAS, the SAFER grant may be used to hire or retain personnel to ensure the Fire Department has adequate resources to respond and safely perform at incidents, providing protection from fire and fire-related hazards for the City; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of said SAFER grant will benefit the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the SAFER grant required prompt acceptance by the City prior to adoption of this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The agreement of the City Manager with the Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency on behalf of the Terrell Fire Department for acceptance of a grant under the FY 2018 Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (“SAFER”) grant program in the amount of One Million Sixty-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$1,069,715.00), is hereby ratified retroactively as of the date of acceptance. The City reserves all rights relating to implementation of the grant.


Section 2. Authorizing the Interim City Manager to execute any documents necessary to implement this Grant.

Section 3. Notice of the passage of this Resolution shall be given by publishing the title and contents once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Terrell.

Section 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Terrell, such emergency being to recognize the immediate acceptance by the City Manager of the grant award.


Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
