

# CITY OF TERRELL BRUSH MANAGEMENT POLICY

The City of Terrell offers two easy ways for Terrell residents to dispose of brush:

## Terrell Citizens Convenience Station

### Location:

County Rd 319/Flowers Ln (between N State Highway 34 & FM 429)

### Hours of Operation:

Wednesday 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.  
Saturday 8:00 a.m. to noon

- No fee for brush disposal which includes tree limbs, brush, shrubs and other green waste.
- No other waste can be included.
- Proof of residency may be required in the form of a valid Driver's License and a stub from the most current utility bill from the City of Terrell.

## Curbside Pick-up

Waste Connections will pick up no more than five (5) cubic yards of brush at the curb on Thursday or Friday (the second weekly trash day).

### Requirements:

- No single piece more than eight (8) feet in length, or 75 lbs.
- No more than a total of five (5) cubic yards.

Drivers will report addresses with brush piles to their dispatch office so it can be added to their pick-up list. Contact Waste Connections at (972) 524-1665, to report brush that has been out for more than seven (7) days.

All debris generated from a Commercial Tree Trimming Company must be hauled off by the Company that provided the services.

Listed below is an example of acceptable brush for curbside pick-up only:

### Thursday/Friday Pick-up

Brush Requirements:

- No single piece more than eight (8) feet in length, or 75lbs.
- No more than a total of five (5) cubic yards will be collected each week.
