



Mobile Food Unit Permit Process Checklist

Permits will expire December 31 of each calendar year. All items must be completed and submitted in order to obtain a permit to operate a Mobile Food Unit in the City of Terrell.

Mobile Food Unit Permit cost is \$50.00

- Completed application
- Completed Mobile Food Unit Inspection
- Copy of last commissary inspection
- Copy of current commissary permit – local, county or state
- Valid Driver's License of person operating the vehicle
- Proof of insurance on vehicle being permitted
- Copy of Certified Food Manager Certification
- Menu

Mobile Food Unit Inspections are conducted the 1st and 3rd Thursday of each month from 9:30 am to 12 pm at:

Permits will not be issued without a passing inspection. All food trucks must have a City of Terrell Mobile Food Unit sticker located in the rear of the vehicle clearly visible to City employees.
